

## Key to species of New World *Stilbops* (Hymenoptera: Ichneumonidae: Stilbopinae)

1. Ventral surface of flagellum yellowish-brown or light brown (Fig. 1). T5-9 dark brown to fuscous in both sexes. T2-3 of female mostly to entirely brownish-red (Fig. 2), black in male (Fig. 3). Female with propodeal carinae complete and strong (Fig. 4). Distribution: northeastern North America.  
..... ***latibasis*** Townes
- 1'. Flagellum uniformly dark brown (Fig. 5). T6-9 brownish-red in female, black in male. T2-3 black in both sexes (Figs. 6-7). Female with propodeal carina weak; posterior transverse carina absent and longitudinal carinae apically absent (Fig. 8). Distribution: southern Mexico (Oaxaca).
